#### **Approval of Minutes:**

the Chief to check with the Township & Village for project revenues for the coming years.

<u>Chief's Report</u>: There was (1) structure fire within the village, 6 unit apartment with electrical problems. There were (8) accidents with 5 that were PI. There were (2) mutual aid assists for the month. Medical 614 YTD, total calls 792 YTD. Kristi stated she did check with the village manager on ordinances for Meadow Lark and Julius stated there not any ordinances which would require Meadow Lark to perform their own medical responses. Julius was to call Meadow Lark.

Joint Training with Village employees: The board discussed a need for a training session for village employees. The village currently is demolishing a home a 11 S. Union and like to use it for a training session. Items to be included in the training: What can a village employee do to assist? What a village employee cannot do. The Chain of command at a Fire Department dispatched location. How best to establish 2 —way communications with the Sparta Police Department. Training tasks for village employees, Kent County dispatch requirements for fire and police. (note) It was stated the location will be demolishing within the 30-45 days so the training on site needs to be completed by that time.

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## **New Business:**

**Purchase Air Cylinders:** The Chief present (3) quotes/plans for the new tanks. The existing tanks have exceeded their service dates. Douglass was \$17,134.66 for life time tanks, Praxair was \$9189.84 for 15 year tanks and Praxair had a 5 years lease for \$4830.23.

Motion: Made by Whalen to purchase the 15 year tanks from Praxair for \$9189.84

**Purchase Lucas 2 Maintenance contract:** The Chief noted that Sparta was the first in the area to purchase the Lucas 2 system. There currently are no others in the area that have a maintenance agreement or have had any problems with the Lucas 2 system. The quote is for a 1 or 4-year maintenance contract for the Lucas 2.

Motion: Made by Goodfellow to purchase Lucas 2 Maintenance contract for 1 year @ at cost of \$1162.50
